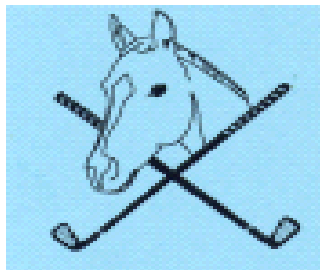


THE WILTSHIRE GOLF CAPTAINS
